Making music is what **SAYM** is all about. Our young musicians club offers young people the opportunity to play/sing in a choir, band, orchestra or group whatever their standard. We've been making music for 30 years bringing young people together to perform in a friendly environment, where the emphasis is on enjoyment as much as achievement.

With our wide range of ensembles SAYM caters for all levels of musicianship, see overleaf. All meet weekly during term time and give regular concerts throughout the year.

If you would like to **join SAYM** or would like to make enquiries, more information can be obtained from our website or email admin@saym.org.uk. Alternatively, come along on a Saturday morning and join in. If you are not sure which level you are at, the SAYM ensemble leaders will be able to advise you as to which group would be best. To join our more senior groups (Senior Wind Band, Young Jazz 1, Salisbury Youth Orchestra) there is normally a short informal audition.

The **Friends of SAYM** (Charity No:1129482) run SAYM with financial support from the Arts Council via Wiltshire Music Connect. They ask for a contribution towards the running costs of SAYM in the form of a membership subscription rather than a per activity/by the hour fee (see below). This termly club subscription entitles a young musician to membership of as many suitable groups as they wish to join. We do not want there to be financial barriers to participation in the music making at SAYM so do let us know if the cost of the subscription is an issue. Come and try it first and then we can sort out the money.
