Concert Day Rehearsals

Spring Spectacular 1:

Rehearsal Slot: 12.00 – 1.45pm

Young musicians will only be playing for some of the time in this rehearsal slot and will be supervised when not playing. An important session in terms of getting used to a new music making space. It might be good to have a book to read or something similar to keep entertained.

Spring Spectacular 2

Rehearsal Slot: 5.15 – 6.45pm

Young musicians will only be playing for some of the time in this rehearsal slot and will be supervised when not playing. An important session in terms of getting used to a new music making space. It might be good to have a book to read or something similar to keep entertained.

Young musicians should arrive no earlier than 15 minutes before the time shown for their rehearsal. They should bring something to eat and drink if required. It is also a good idea to ensure that instrument cases have a name tag as there will be a lot of instruments and cases all looking the same. **Please wear concert dress to the rehearsal.**

Supervision: Young musicians of primary age in the junior groups will be supervised between the rehearsal and concert and should not leave the building under any circumstances, short of an emergency evacuation of the building. Secondary age young musicians will need to sign out and back in again if they leave the building between rehearsal and concert

Please note - The SAYM team will not be able to supervise between the two concerts and pupils need to remain under the care of their parents/carers during this period.
