Please wear concert dress to the rehearsal.

These are drop off times, there will be no audience seating available during the rehearsals. Audience admitted from 3.00pm for the afternoon concert and 7.15pm for the evening concert.

Supervision: Young musicians will be supervised between the rehearsal and concert and should not leave the building under any circumstances, short of an emergency evacuation of the church. **Please note that there is no supervision of young musicians possible between the end of the afternoon concert and evening concert rehearsal.**

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
